

And Then There Were None Code of Conduct

Below is the code of conduct for *And Then There Were None*. This code is to be upheld by all participants and crew when engaging with the larp during, before, and after the runtime.

1. Inclusivity

This code of conduct is not inclusive. Any actions which create a hostile or unsafe environment for participants or organisers — whether written in this code or not — can be reported to the organisers. Actions not explicitly documented here can still lead to official warnings or suspension from the game. Signing up for *And Then There Were None* constitutes presumed acceptance of these conditions.

2. Our policy on harassment

We are dedicated to creating a harassment-free experience for everyone involved. This means we will not permit any harassment based on, but not limited to, gender expression, race, (dis)ability, age, or physical appearance. We do not tolerate any instances of harassment and any participant or staff member violating these rules, at our discretion, will be expelled from the larp immediately without a refund.

3. Alcohol and drugs

During *And Then There Were None* alcohol will be available. Drinking alcohol is completely optional. We trust our players to know their own limits when it comes to alcohol but will not hesitate to intervene if we deem a player too intoxicated to safely participate in the game. Pretending to be drunk and spilling your characters secrets is fun, but being too drunk to roleplay is not. Additionally, all recreational drugs are banned from our event.

4. Hard limits

The following acts are not permitted at all during the game:

- Non-simulated sex
- Full nudity
- Touching of genitals
- Racism or comments based on players off game identity including but not limited to physical appearance, sexuality, gender, or religion.

5. The off-game room and safety staff on site

During the game the organisers will be available at all times in the off-game room for check-ins and questions. One of our organisers is a trained social work professional and will be available to talk to you if any issues arise or there are any concerns you want to discuss. Due to the small scale of this larp there will not be any safety-team members outside the core organiser team. There will be a first aid kit available in this room as well, and an organizer trained in first response.

6. Dietary Needs

We will be contacting players to inquire about any specific medical or dietary needs you may have. We cannot accommodate everything, but we will do our best to cater to your requirements and, where possible, work them into the larp. We will clearly communicate what is and isn't possible before the game, and if you let us know well in advance a lot is possible.
